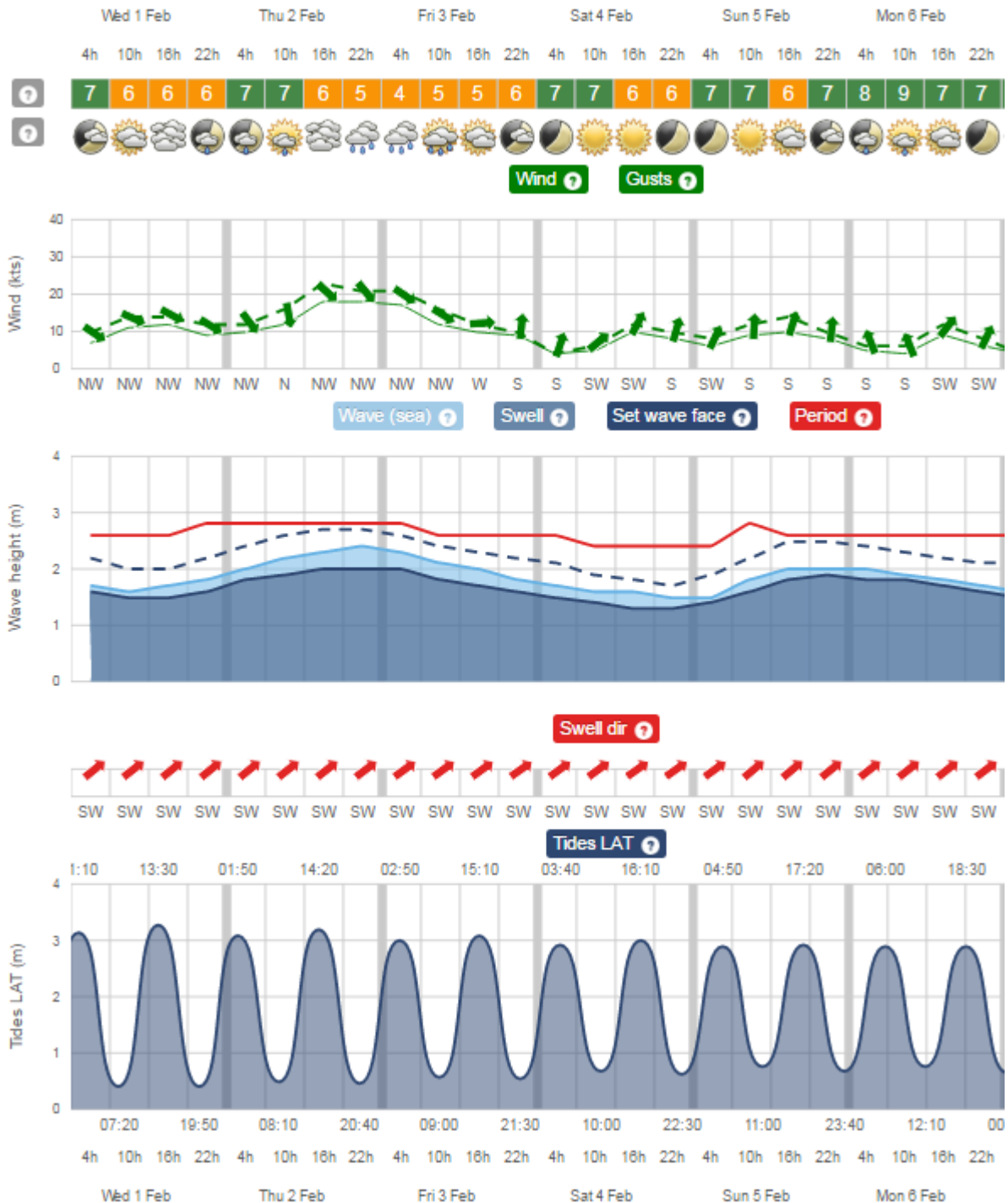

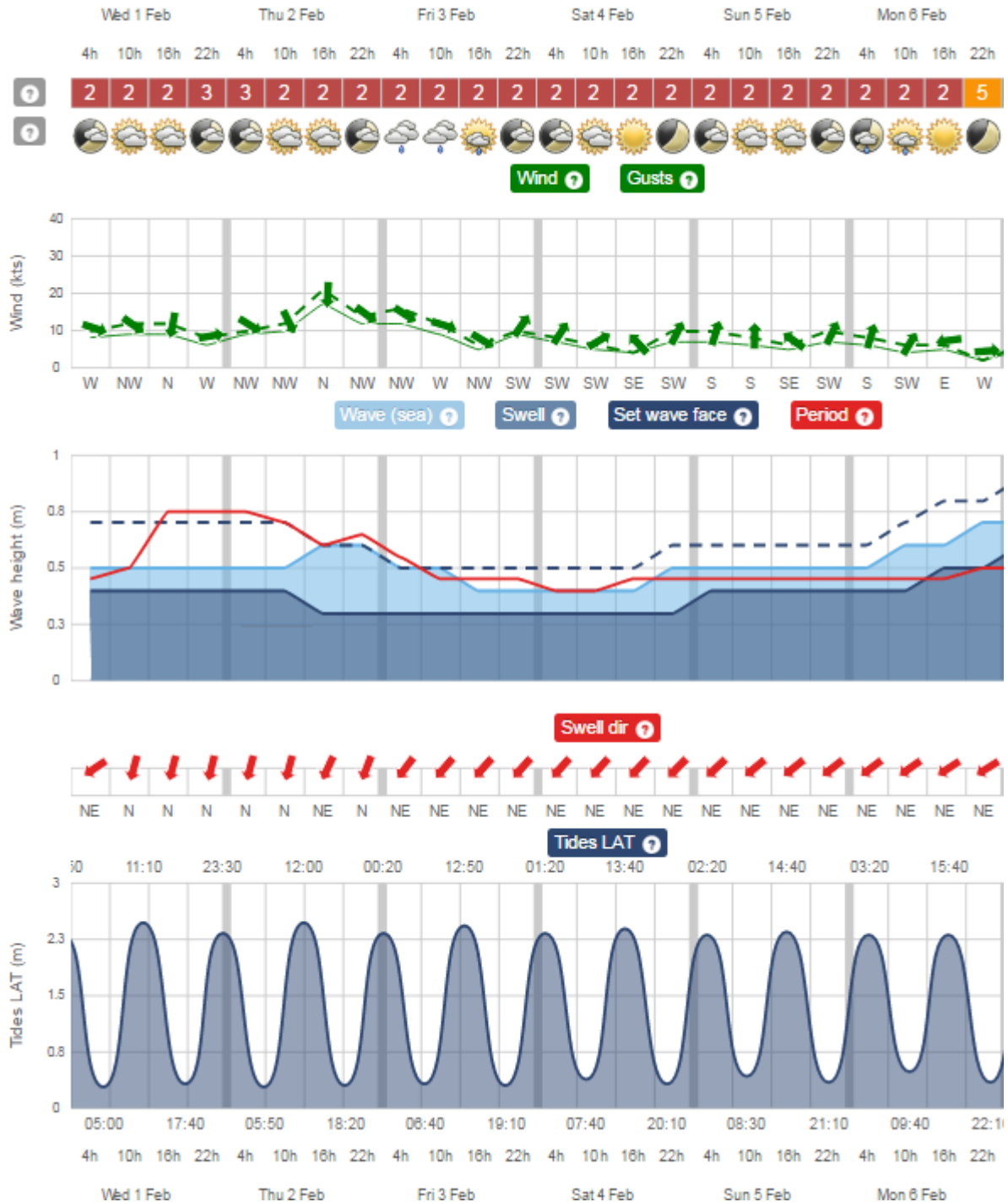

Radio Network:
