Minimum Patrol Hours:

1100-1600 *North Shore Satellite beaches: 1100-1600*

All patrols must be carried out to the outlined minimum hours as per each Clubs Service Level Agreement. We strongly urge patrols to continue on in the evening if there are large numbers of swimmers and / or conditions that may lead to people getting into difficulty without a patrol (be sure to inform SurfCom). Thanks to those patrols that do regularly extend their hours where appropriate.

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

SwellMap marine forecasts



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

Radio Network:

Bethells Beach Repeater has an intermitted fault leading to the loss of radio communication at times with the patrol on the rescue network. Until this is resolved, Bethells patrol should dedicate one radio to monitoring mode 4, which transmits to and from Piha's repeater.

If you encounter an issue with the network please use the [fault matrix](#) and liaise with SurfCom and test the network with at least 2 different radios (base set and handheld if possible) and ask SurfCom to log the issue if not already completed.
