Earlier in the season, clubs were asked to provide SLSNZ with numbers of shirt sizes they needed. This order was placed, however the order was unable to be filled by SLSNZ, especially the larger sizes. Due to this, uniforms were only distributed to lifeguards who qualified this season as they were yet to receive a uniform. For the duration of the season, lifeguards may wear their old uniforms as long as they meet the Uniform Guidelines. These can be found here [Circular 044:17](#)

What do I need to know?
