Subject: TSB Bank Surf Lifesaving Grant

Attention: Club Chairs

Action: Apply for Grant funding by 10th August

There are 11 grants available totalling \$100,000 (excluding GST):

- \$20,000 (x 2)
- \$10,000 (x 3)
- \$5,000 (x 6)

Grants are available for the following:

Maintenance – defined as club house repairs, maintenance, building or rebuilding (this includes refurbishment, painting, etc).

Equipment – defined as surf lifesaving equipment.

Training – defined as member training or education (excluding travel, food, accommodation)

A club may only apply for one grant and must choose the appropriate category for their application. To apply for a grant please [click here](#) to visit the TSB Bank website and complete the online form.

Applications will close at **2pm Thursday 10 August**.

I would urge you to consider applying for the **smaller amounts** to support your clubs equipment servicing and maintenance needs or potentially to address externally provided first aid or VHF training costs. This is because there are more, smaller grants than there are larger grants and if you apply for a larger grant and are unsuccessful you will **not** automatically be allocated a lesser award.

I have already highlighted the poor maintenance leading to safety concerns of some of the club equipment and, as the Foundation North funding currently can't be used for maintenance, a \$5k or \$10k grant from TSB would go a long way to ensuring your clubs ATV's and power craft are professionally serviced and ready for the season ahead.
