Description: Further explanation regarding who requires Police vetting

Recently, there has been some confusion as to who needs to be Police Vetted under the new SLSNR Safeguarding Policy.

Anyone with an SLSNZ membership number, who is in the CRM database and 18 years or older is required to be Police Vetted. This includes those who have Primary Membership or Associate Membership. Because each Club defines what an Associate Member is differently, SLSNR's position is that the requirement for Police Vetting is determined by the activity that the Associate Member undertakes. If your Club has Associate Members that are funders or supporters but not active in the Club then these members would not require Police vetting. However, if your Club has Associate Members that stay overnight at the club or are Junior Surf Coaches/Helpers then they would require Police vetting.
