Clubs that aren't listed above and still wish to be considered for accredited call-out squad inclusion need members who are over 18 and at this stage a 400m timed swim for members in under 9 minutes is the only other requirement. Once completed the time simply has to be updated by your Club Lifesaving Officer or Callout Squad Co-ordinator on the shared Dropbox folder.

To ensure this process continues and members are to fulfil the 2017/18 service level agreement **could clubs ensure members are refreshed by the 31st January 2018** (First Aid, Surf Lifeguard Award and Senior Lifeguard Award).
