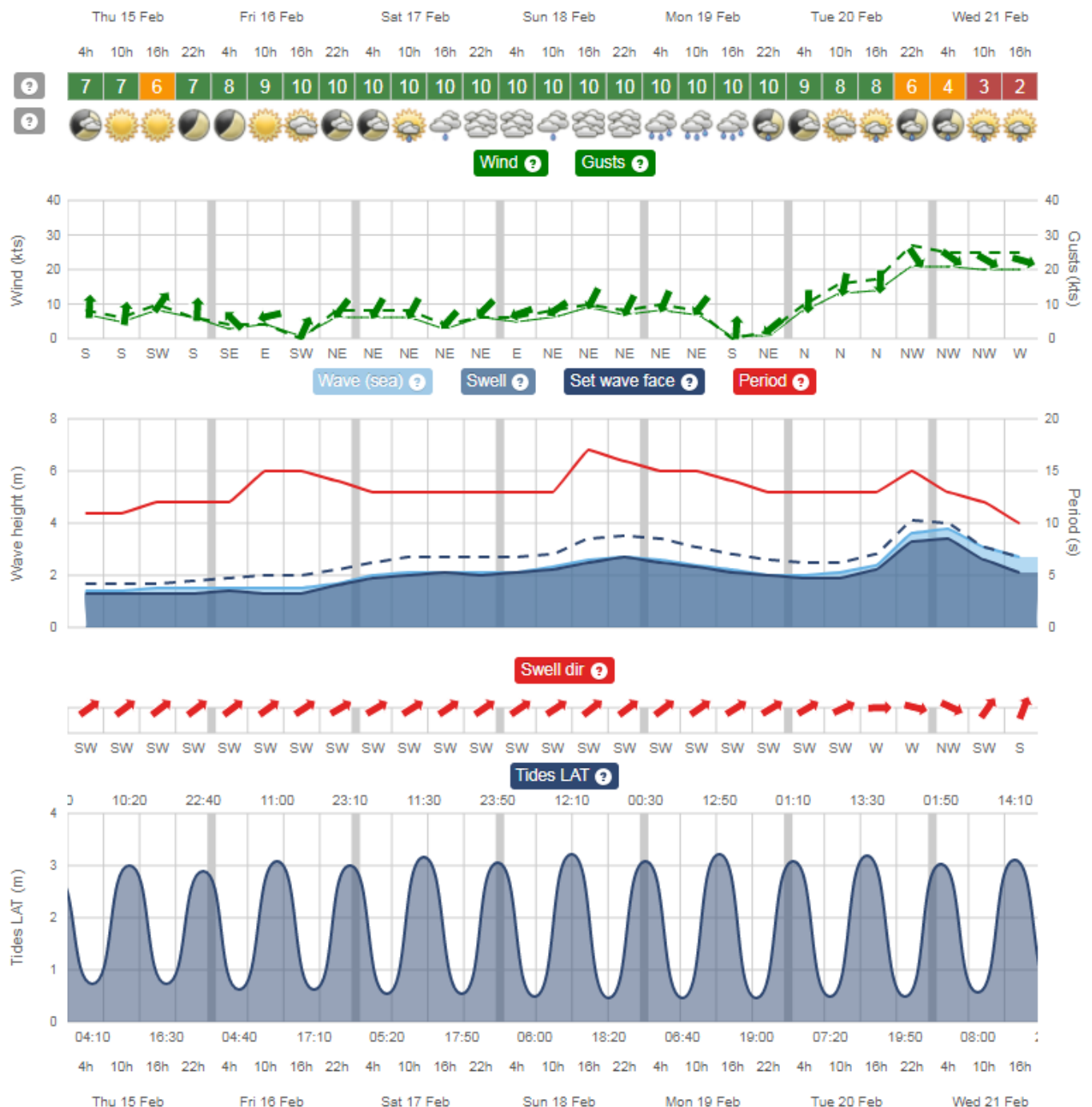

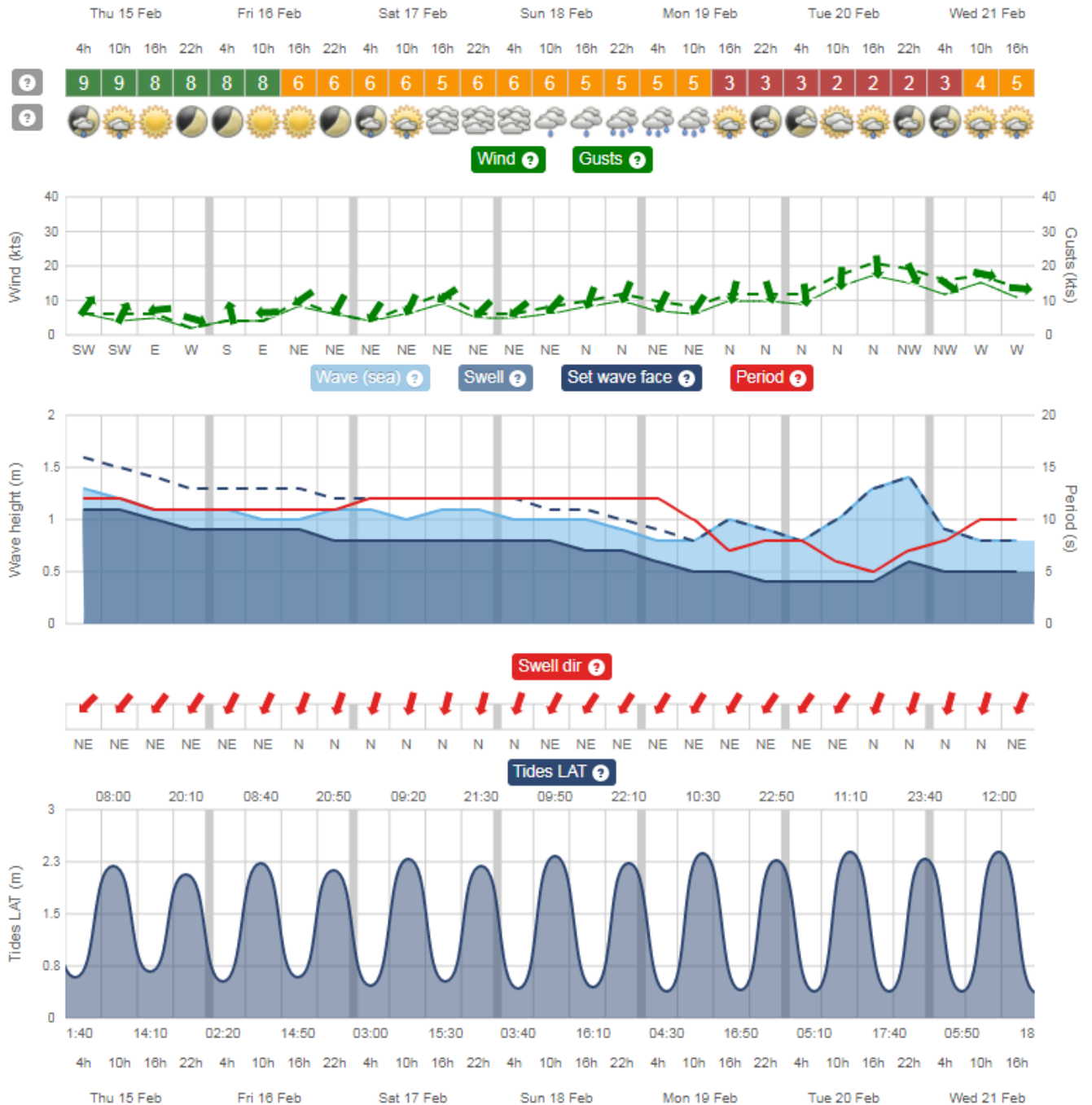
Conditions outlook for the Eastcoast (Mangawhai Heads forecast):
