SLSNZ has established a new Powercraft Advisory Group (PAG) to ensure there is expert volunteer advice on all aspects of powercraft policy, safety, development and use.

The group will report directly to both the National Lifesaving Committee and the National Sport Committee, providing oversight and guidance on the use of IRBs, RWCs, ATVs, 4WD vehicles and any other powered rescue & surveillance equipment.

Meeting face to face at least once a year, thereafter by teleconference, the group of seven appointed experts from the SLSNZ membership will be supported by key SLSNZ staff.

The first face to face meeting has already been scheduled for Saturday 27th October at Auckland Airport. Whilst availability to attend this meeting is not a pre-requisite to being appointed to the PAG, it was considered important to set a date now because there is an interesting and important work plan for the group that needs input from members sooner rather than later.
