#### Overview

Since 1969 senior lifeguards have been selected from clubs in the Northern Region, to visit lifeguard agencies in California. The exchange is a structured learning experience, and is an opportunity for clubs to nominate exceptional lifeguards who show the ability to enhance surf lifesaving in this country.

With the assistance of the host organisation – California Surf Life Saving Association – the exchange delegates are given the opportunity to participate in patrolling activities, to witness and practice the use of different types of rescue equipment, and to observe alternative beach management programmes and administrative structures.

The California Lifeguard Exchange is the second pillar of the **Buddy Lucas Leadership Scholarship**. The Buddy Lucas Leadership Scholarship is funded by **Denis Black**, Patron of SLSNR and Life member of both SLSNZ and SLSNR. It provides prospective leaders the opportunity to develop and expand their knowledge of Surf Life Saving and develop their own personal skills. Through this scholarship the successful candidates will have their operational costs covered. **Click here** for more information.

Successful applicants will demonstrate a high level of knowledge of New Zealand's lifeguarding arrangements, be highly proficient in a range of practical patrolling and rescue skills, and have the ability to impart this to others through prepared presentations and coordination of hosting duties on their return.

Selectors will be looking for candidates who can successfully evaluate the benefits of the alternative systems and techniques they observe, have had a consistent involvement in SLS over a long period of time and who will continue to actively participate in the development and administration of surf lifesaving following the exchange (i.e. have earned it, will learn and develop from it, and will continue to contribute after it).

















### **Selection Process**

The selection process will be undertaken by an advisory group appointed by the Club Development Advisory Group. This will include a former exchange delegate, a recent exchange delegate and a staff member from the SLSNR Operation's Team. Applicants will be advised in writing if they have been short-listed for an interview, and if so, the time and place for this. An announcement of the successful applicants will be made no later than April 2019.

### Selectors' decision to be final

The selection sub-committee's decision will be final, and their deliberations will remain confidential to the appointed advisory group.

#### **CRITERIA**

All applicants for the 2019 California Lifeguard Exchange must satisfy the following criteria before submitting their completed application form to Surf Life Saving Northern Region by <u>Applications</u> Close: 1700hrs, 5<sup>th</sup> March 2019

- Have attained 21 years of age by 1 June 2019
- Be available for travel for a five or six week period, from the last week of June until early August 2019.
- Be a financial, refreshed and active patrolling member of a SLS affiliated Club in the Northern Region. (Endorsed as such by your club)
- Have demonstrated significant involvement at both Club and/or Regional levels, consistently over many years.
- Have demonstrated a desire and commitment towards the organisation in the future.
- Be available to coordinate the hosting program of the 2019-2020 NZ leg.
- Be able to demonstrate ability to meet financial costs associated with the exchange eg. living expenses etc.
- Demonstrate the physical ability and competence to participate in the full range of lifeguard activities associated with the exchange (competent swimmer and all-round good fitness)
- Complete the medical information and disclaimer.
