Do not call SurfCom direct.</u></b></p> <p><b>Delta 2 will be reflex tasked by Delta 1 during an incident based on which Duty Officers are nearby, healthy and available during the lockdown period.</b></p> <p><b>No medical or land search incidents will be attended by lifeguards during the lockdown. In-water rescues, searches and recoveries will only be at the request/signoff of Police.</b></p>
