- 2. <u>Beach athletes</u> demonstrating development potential and attitude, as evidenced by:
 - a. Club performances, training & club coach feedback;
 - b. Performances at SLSNR & SLSNZ events;
- 3. Pool Rescue athletes demonstrating development potential and attitude, as evidenced by:
 - a. Club performances, training & club coach feedback;
 - b. Performances at SLSNR & SLSNZ events;
- 4. IRB Racing Crews demonstrating development potential and attitude, as evidenced by:
 - a. Club performances, training & club coach feedback;
 - b. Performances at SLSNR & SLSNZ events;
- 5. **Surf Boat Crews** demonstrating development potential and attitude, as evidenced by:
 - a. Club performances, training & club coach feedback;
 - b. Performances at SLSNR & SLSNZ events;
- 6. Athletes who have displayed historical results across any of the above disciplines;
- 7. All the above criteria being subject to the athlete:
 - a. Being a financial member of an SLSNR club & holder of a refreshed SLG Award.
 - b. Demonstrating a positive attitude to surf sport development on an individual and team level; and
 - c. Contributing to the positive reputation of SLSNR.
